## Main objectives of the meeting

The project "Mediterranean coastal lagoons management: interactions between aquaculture and capture fisheries (LaMed-2)" was designed and developed to explore the main issues dealing with the interactions between aquaculture and capture fisheries (IACF) in Mediterranean coastal lagoons toward a sustainable management of these environments. It is also aimed at providing guidelines and recommendations related to the interaction of capture fisheries and aquaculture using a systemic approach in the four dimensions of sustainability (environmental, economic, social and governance). Within the project, an evaluation of the economic and environmental accounting and cost benefit analysis of the activities will be performed within the overall context of Integrated Coastal Zone Management and in an Ecosystem Approach for Aquaculture perspective.

The aim of this meeting is to present and discuss the main issues related the interaction between aquaculture and capture fisheries in the coastal lagoons and the management of these environments within the GFCM region. The aims of this meeting is also is to prepare a background information and technical material in support to the activities of the LaMed-2.

In particular, the meeting has been assigned the following objectives:

- Establishment of a network of Mediterranean experts (IACF) on coastal lagoons throughout the Region;
- Review and preparation of a synthesis of the main issues related to the management of coastal lagoons;
- Presentation and discussion of national reports related to the description and to the management of coastal lagoons for aquaculture, highlighting the lack of knowledge and the difficulties in collecting information on certain issues related to the interactions among aquaculture, fisheries and environment;
- Presentation and discussion on issues related to lagoon management (lagoon case studies; biodiversity and conservation; stock enhancement; nursery areas; eel management, green accounting; environmental and economics accounts, etc.);
- Identification of priorities and discussion on guidelines for a sustainable management of coastal lagoons;
- Preliminary identification of indicators for the sustainable development of aquaculture and capture fisheries activities within coastal lagoons;
- Discussion on the relevance of coastal lagoons conservation both in a publica and private perspective;

The outputs of the meeting will also serve as a basic contribution for the production of criteria for the preparation of guidelines on the development of sustainable aquaculture activities in Mediterranean coastal lagoons.

#### Languages

It is expected that English will be the main language for discussions. Meeting will be opened to stakeholders.
