### **Main objectives of the meeting**

The Project in support to the GFCM CAQ Working Group on Sustainability in Aquaculture: Indicators for Sustainable Development of Aquaculture and Guidelines for their use in the Mediterranean (InDAM) is operative since November 2008. The project is funded with the contribution of European Commission (EC) DG Mare.

The aims of InDAM, among other and through a participatory and multidisciplinary approach, are to provide policy makers and relevant stakeholders, with a comprehensive decision support tool regarding sustainable aquaculture development in the Mediterranean.

This tool is based on the production of sets of indicators and relative reference points and standards to guide evaluate and provide incentives towards the sustainable development of Mediterranean aquaculture in its four dimensions (social, economic, environmental and governance) and within an ecosystem based framework.

Main objectives of the meeting will be:

- Selection of Regional Indicators to be considered for the sustainable development of aquaculture in the Mediterranean region
- Priority issues for the WGSAs and synergies with relevant projects and initiatives related to sustainable development of aquaculture existing in the Mediterranean area.
- Background information will be given on the Pilot Studies carried out in Morocco, Spain, Turkey and Tunisia. The extension of pilot studies in other areas to disseminate the experience gained will be discussed.
- Presentation of the Pilot Study in Turkey, second step (InDAM Pilot Project in Turkey Pilot Study, Mugla on the identification of indicators for sustainable aquaculture) 28-29 September 2009
- Presentation of the Pilot Study in Tunisia, second step(InDAM Pilot Project in Tunisia Pilot Study, Monastir on the identification of indicators for sustainable aquaculture)13-14 October 2009
- Presentation of the Pilot Study in Spain, Andalucia,( InDAM Pilot Project in Spain on the identification of indicators for sustainable aquaculture) 23-25 May 2011
- Presentation of the Pilot Study in Morocco, M'Diq (InDAM Pilot Project in Morocco on on the identification of indicators for sustainable aquaculture)26-28 November 2011
- WGSAs on InDAM Programme of work for 2012 and beyond
