Recommendations

- set up a minimum size
- prohibit the harvesting of the shallow water
- carry out regional pilot studies to assess the impact of the use of new technologies to harvest red coral, (ROV etc..).
- establish a quota system based on number of licenses $% \left(x_{1},x_{2}\right) =x_{1}^{2}$
- set up a system of no-take zones
- promote a participatory approach of all the stakeholders.
- collect annual data according to GFCM Task 1 requirements


Main technical characteristics of Mediterranean bottom trawls

Comprehensive information on national & regional legislation on fisheries and technical characteristics

Recommendations:

- Continue to make selectivity experiments on the base of the standardized methodology adopted in GFCM-ATSELMED 1 (Sète, 2005)
- Carry out experiments on alternative or complementary technical devices
- Prepare a new versus of this protocol including socio-economical indicators to collect.
- Encourage using pots and traps instead of towed gears & evaluate economic and social effects
- Draw up an Atlas for the different Mediterranean trawls by countries and GSA with reference on main target species and available selectivity parameters.

10th COORDINATION MEETING OF THE SUBCOMMITTEES (CMSC)

St George's Bay, Malta, 3rd December 2010

Proposals from the 4 sub comm. Endorsed by the CSC:

- Carry out a regional study to obtain an overview of recreational fishing activities
- Elaborate a Code of Practice/technical guidelines for the management of recreational fisheries in the GFCM area
- SAC should discuss on a mechanism to optimise the submission of fleetbased information, in reducing the number of datasets
 - Look for a Permanent Statistical Assistance Entity within the GFCM Secretariat.
 - Elaborate a list of "unwanted" species to be included in the Task 1 reporting schen
- Task 1 data access policy :statistical bulletin and other general statistical outputs shauld be to the public by default. SAC should only discuss the modality of data access
 - SAC should discuss whether there is sufficient evidence to set up a threshold effec in reporting catches through logbooks

10th COORDINATION MEETING OF THE SUBCOMMITTEES (CMSC)

- Include the bycatch on elasmobranches, gelatinous zooplankton, algae & red coral in the data submission protocol of GFCM (task 1.4)
 - Organize an assessment meeting on Elasmobranches for 2011 considering the ongoing works of ICCAT and ICES
 - · Recommend the management measures proposed for the Red Coral
 - Update of the TECHNOMED selectivity protocol
- Hold a workshop for Elasmobranch stock assessment using "less data demanding" methods, inside the Demersals WG (4 sp. ready to be assessed in 2011).
 - Consider the possibility of using of circular hooks, grids and separators to specific fisheries
 - Analyze the effects of a wide range of square mesh sizes and of separator panels

 - Maintain close collaboration between SAC and RAC/SPA (as in 2010 for elasmobranches, eel, bycatch reduction and selectivity).
