Main objectives

The 35th Session of the GFCM agreed to convene a workshop to follow up some pending issues opened to discussion during the sessions held at the first workshop of 2010. The main aims of this workshop are to address research and management actions to be undertaken for the sustainable exploitation of red coral in the Mediterranean and Black Sea. Specifically, the workshop will:

- 1. Review of the distribution (past and actual) and present status of deep red coral banks across the Mediterranean region.
- 2. Review existing and new data on biology, ecology, oceanography, genetics and fisheries of deep red coral banks
- 3. Define the way the harvested quantities must be reported to the GFCM (*eg.* task 1, specific submission forms, Statlant 37A...) in compliance with the Recommendation GFCM/35/2011/2.
- 4. Assess the information received at the Secretariat on the number of authorizations issued (specifying the date of their issuance) for the use of ROV subject to the conditions stated at the for the as stated in the Rec. GFCM/35/2011/2 before the end of September 2011.
- 5. Evaluate of measures and strategies for planning local and regional management and conservation plans.
- 6. Outline a Scientific Medium Term Working Plan for red coral according to the main lines defined in the first workshop.

Call for Scientific Papers and Data

Participants are encouraged to submit relevant scientific papers. The titles, names of authors and abstracts of papers should be submitted to GFCM (GFCM-Secretariat@fao.org) by 7th September, 2011. Authors are also encouraged to submit completed electronic versions of their papers before the meeting in order to make them available on the Internet.

Experts are requested to provide information on the state of red coral in the Mediterranean in particular connected to biology, fisheries and regulations.

Languages

English, French, Spanish and Arabic may be used for preparation of workshop papers or for data submission. However, no interpretation services will be available. It is expected that English will be the main language for presentations and discussions.
