

Background on the Task Force

- ToRs for a Task Force agreed At the 35th session of the GFCM after a review of GFCM performances having been undertaken
- The Task Force is to ensure the adequate follow up to the recommendations elaborated by the Panel that reviewed GFCM performances
- It is clearly stated in the mandate of the Task Force that the ultimate goal is the adoption of a new agreement or the amendment of the existing one
- GFCM Bureau and Secretariat will supervise the works of the Task Force
- Points of reference (treaties and soft law agreements) have been identified to facilitate the works of the Task Force

Task Force

- Methodology
- 10 identified areas, each one with sub issues
- Focus also on decision making and how ensuring a better functioning of GFCM, including the link between the Commission and the committees
- Identified issues are without prejudice to the possibility of addressing those which are not mentioned in the ToRs of the Task Force

Work Programme of the Task Force

- Preparatory work for the Task Force (letters and focal points + questionnaire)
- Meeting of experts SAC/CAQ organized (15-16 December)
- Meetings in various GFCM sub-regions in 2012
- Concluding meeting of the Task Force tentatively scheduled for April 2012
- 36th Session of the Commission will adopt the necessary decisions




Framework Programme (FWP)

- Strategic frame for the GFCM and in support of GFCM Task Force activities
- Platform to promote sustainable development of capture fisheries and aquaculture in the Mediterranean and Black Sea
- 5-year span: 2013-2018
- 2.5 million Euro/yr budget
- Multi-annual / multi-donor arrangements
- 7 indentified Work Programmes based on actual issues and needs

FWP Work Programmes

- 1. Ecosystem Approach to Fisheries (EAF)
- 2. Improving data collection and reporting capacity
- 3. Aquaculture and capture fisheries and Integrated Coastal Zone Management (ICZM)
- 4. Marine Protected Areas (MPAs) and artificial reefs
- 5. Enhancing artisanal fisheries
- 6. Strengthening fisheries management in the Black Sea area
- 7. Supporting capture fisheries and aquaculture in the Southern Mediterranean Sea



The Strategy

- Focus on priorities at regional level in the context of sustainable development (Rio +20) e.g. food security, poverty alleviation, resource supply shortage, etc
- Foster strategic cooperation with partner organizations to implement joint initiatives
- Strengthen regional coordination and create synergies with on-going programmes

- Identify a Road Map for the FWP
- Fine tuning towards finalization of the Work Programmes
- Identification and prioritization of Work Packages
- Finalization of FWP by May 2012 (36th Session of GFCM)
- Presentation to donors and Member Countries in the meantime
